SUPERHERO SPRINT

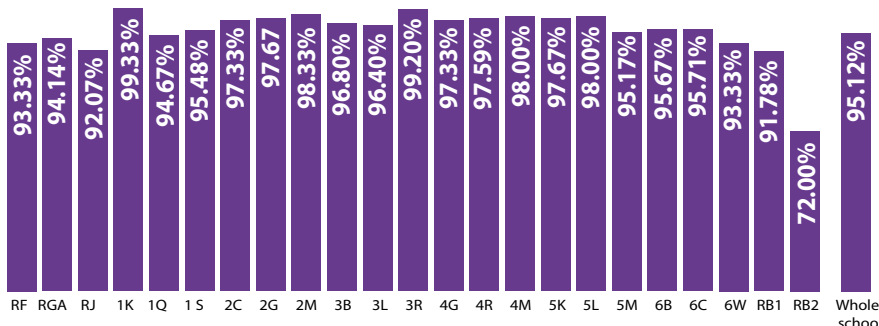
Thank you to everyone who took part in the Sponsored Superhero Sprint - specially to the parents who joined us as the weather was particularly warm.
