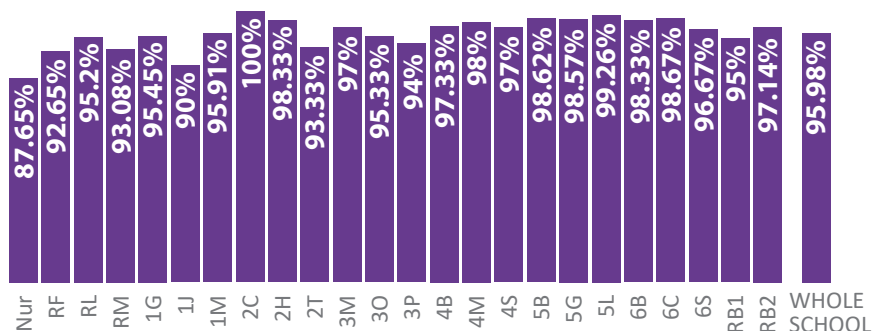

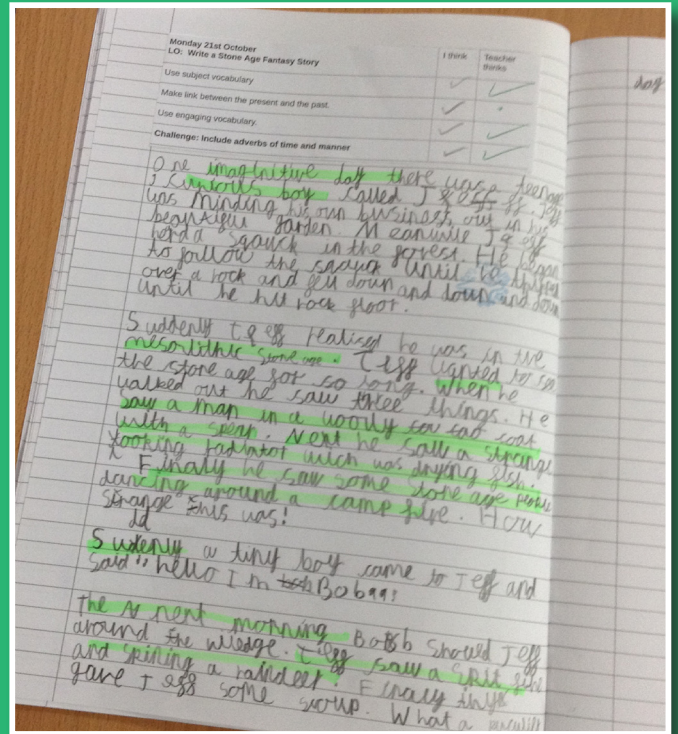
YEAR 6 MUSIC CONCERT
