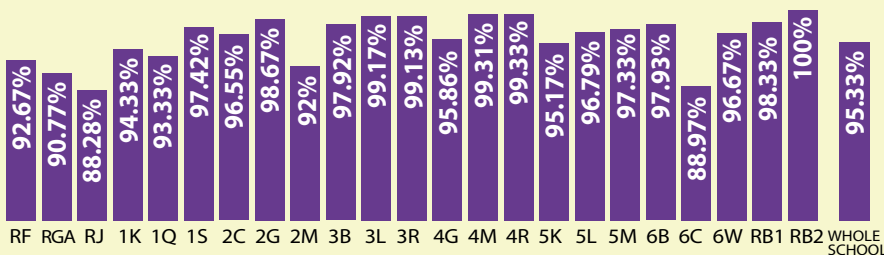
ATTENDANCE
