We asking for a donation of £1 per child 50p will be donated to The Red Tree Fund and 50p to The National Autistic Society

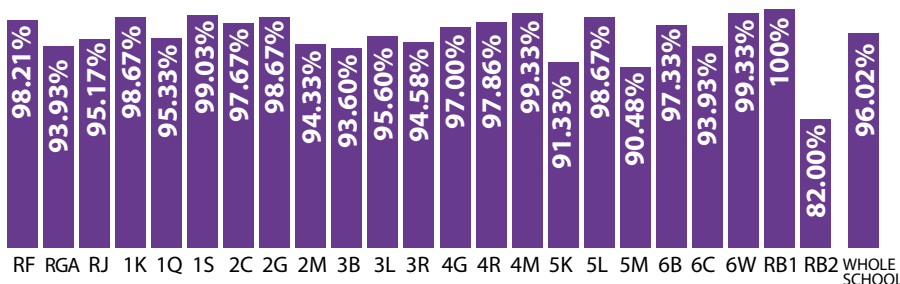


